Mahan Develops Safety Training and Operations Center

C.J. Mahan Construction Company has contracted with Dublin Building Systems for construction of a new Safety Training and Operations Center located in Grove City, Ohio adjacent to Mahan's corporate headquarters. The facility, which includes over 3000 sf of safety administration offices and 3000 sf of training area, is scheduled for completion in mid-June. The facility is designed to provide a dedicated environment for safety training, project-specific planning and administration of the company's comprehensive safety program. The offices will be occupied by Corporate Safety Director, Hope Matheny, and staff of project safety inspectors, trainers, administrators and compliance officers.

Additionally, dedicated indoor mock-up space for training on scaffolding, water rescue, lifting procedure, fall protection, hazardous material handling and site-specific safety considerations is being constructed. This space will allow Mahan to recreate both examples of generally hazardous construction environments such as an elevated scaffold tower as well as specific potentially hazardous conditions existing on projects that the company is constructing. These site-specific hazards could include elevated work platforms, a challenging rigging scenario or a difficult material installation procedure. Mahan is dedicated to working safely and to a culture of constant improvement in mitigation of project safety risks.
