First Paying Customer Unloads Cargo at Port of Cates Landing

The Port of Cates Landing, constructed by Aquarius Marine, LLC, a subsidiary of C.J. It was the first paying customer using the port facility and is the first of seven the port is expecting. The shipment officially declares the port open for business.
