Mahan Continues Growth in Energy Sector with Award of Marathon Petroleum Dock Projects

C.J. Mahan Construction Company, LLC continues their participation in the growth of the country's energy sector with the award of two contracts by Marathon Petroleum Corporation for repairs and expansions to their river dock facilities. The privately-owned projects are located on the Ohio River in Kenova, West Virginia and Catlettsburg, Kentucky and are approximately 4-miles apart.

The Kenova contract is valued at \$2,948,820 and includes the construction of a sheet pile mooring cell, installation of three dock floats, gangway installation for barge access, debris deflector installation, and miscellaneous mechanical, electrical, and structural steel upgrades.

The Catlettsburg work scope is almost identical and is valued at \$2,967,280. Mahan was able to negotiate the terms of both contracts so that the projects' work schedules overlap, passing on a substantial cost savings to Marathon. Work is planned to begin in July 2014 and will complete by November 2014.

Marathon Petroleum is the nation's fourth largest transportation fuels refiner and the largest in the Midwest, with the capacity of producing 1.7 million barrels-per-day. Headquartered in Findlay, Ohio with roots reaching into the early years of the oil industry, the company operates a seven-plant refinery system and markets their petroleum products in the Midwest, Gulf Coast and Southeast.
