I-40 White River Bridge Awarded to Parsons Mahan Joint Venture

On Tuesday, November 2, 2016 the Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid from Parsons Mahan Joint Venture for the construction of a new bridge on Interstate 40 over the White River. Parsons Mahan Joint Venture bettered four competitors to acquire the Project.

The new \$100.8M, 18 span bridge will require 419 working days to complete and will be constructed along the north side of the existing 48-year-old bridge in Prairie County, Arkansas. The nearly 2,844' long steel plate girder bridge will sit on drilled shaft foundations and will be wide enough to accommodate six lanes of traffic. Once the new structure is completed, the existing bridge will be demolished.

Construction will begin in the first quarter of 2017.
