Virginia Rte. 460 Connector Project Awarded ACEC Indiana Engineering Excellence Award

C.J. Mahan Construction Company, LLC (Mahan) is proud to announce that its Virginia Route 460 Connector Project has been honored with the *ACEC Indiana 2016 Engineering Excellence Honor Award*.

Completed in June 2015, the Virginia Route 460 Connector was a design-build, best value project which included a 1,728' long twin, cast-in-place trapezoidal box segmental structure with spans of 268', 489', 489', and 268' plus two precast concrete girders with spans of 110' and 103'. This superstructure was supported by unique H-shaped pier columns with heights in excess of 200'. The bridge is the tallest in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Mahan was one of five recipients of the Honor Award that is given each year by ACEC Indiana to recognize outstanding engineering achievements that demonstrate a high degree of merit and ingenuity.
