Virginia Rte. 460 Connector Project Makes Cover of 'Transportation Builder Magazine'

C.J. Mahan Construction Company (Mahan) is proud to have one of its premier projects, the Virginia Rte. 460 Connector Project, displayed on this month's cover of 'Transportation Builder Magazine'.

'Transportation Builder Magazine' is published by the American Road and Transportation Builders Association (ARTBA), which is the oldest and most respected transportation construction-related association in the nation. The ARTBA was the first to articulate the need for a federally-built network of Interstate Highways, and this vision was achieved with the construction of the Interstate Highway System. ARTBA members designed, built, and continue to maintain the Interstate System, along with the rest of the nation's transportation network.

Mahan is working as the bridge subcontractor on the Virginia Rte. 460 Connector Project featured in the September/October issue. The design-build, best value structure includes a 1,728' long twin cast-in-place segmental structure with trapezoidal box superstructure, segmental spans of 268.5', 489', 489', and 268.5' plus two precast concrete girders with spans of 110' and 103', and unique H-shaped pier columns with heights in excess of 200'. When complete in November 2014, the bridge will be the tallest in the state of Virginia.
