

Working as a subcontractor to Lambert Engineering and owner USACE, Wilmington District, C.J. Mahan Construction Company, LLC was awarded a contract to repair a scour hole at Lock and Dam #2 on the Cape Fear River in Elizabethtown, North Carolina. The river bottom downstream of Lock and Dam #2 is significantly eroded creating a scour hole and threatening the stability of the dam. Mahan's contract, valued at nearly \$8 million, calls for placing granite stone in the scour hole to provide protection to the dam. In total more than 75,000 tons of stone protection will be placed, consisting of underlayer stone topped with two layers of armor stone, with some armor stone weighing more than 2000 pounds each.

Work is scheduled to begin in October 2017 and complete by August 2018.
